

UNIVERSITY OF GUJRAT

ADMISSION POLICY FOR FALL-2026

(SEMESTER SYSTEM)

1. ADMISSION CRITERIA

- 1.1. Online admissions for all degree programs and reserved seats/quotas at the University of Gujrat shall be processed under the Semester System in accordance with the admission advertisement published in print and electronic media.
- 1.2. **For Undergraduate Degree Programs:**
The desirous candidates (Male/Female/Transgender) who have successfully passed all subjects of the **First Year Intermediate** or an equivalent qualification, or the **first two years of a relevant three-year Diploma of Associate Engineering (DAE)** recognized by the Pakistan Board of Technical Education (PBTE), shall be eligible to apply for admission to the undergraduate degree programs offered by the University of Gujrat for Fall 2026. However, such admissions shall remain provisional and shall be confirmed only upon submission and verification of the final result/certificate of the relevant Intermediate qualification, equivalent examination, or DAE before the prescribed deadline notified by the University.
- 1.3. **For Lateral Entry (5th Semester Induction Degree Programs):**
The desirous candidates (Male/Female/Transgender) possessing an **Associate Degree** or **fourteen (14) years of education** from an institution recognized by the **Higher Education Commission (HEC) of Pakistan** shall be eligible to apply for admission to the **BS-Lateral Entry (5th Semester Induction) Programs** in the relevant discipline offered as **Full-Time Evening Programs**. However, the applicants awaiting the result of their final semester/year examination shall be eligible to apply for admission to 5th Semester Induction.
- 1.4. **For Graduate Degree Programs:**
The desirous candidates (Male/Female/Transgender) having **sixteen (16) years of relevant degree** may apply for the **MPhil/MS/MSc/LLM/MBA** degree programs; whereas, **eighteen (18) years of relevant degree** shall be required to apply for **PhD** degree programs. The applicants of the **Graduate Degree Programs** shall have to pass the **Departmental Subject Based Written Test (DSBWT)**. The schedule of the DSBWT is given in the Admission Calendar (**Annexure-III**).
- 1.5. **Important Note:**
Students of the University of Gujrat awaiting the result of their final semester examination shall be eligible to apply for admission to 5th Semester Induction, MPhil/MS/MSc/LLM/MBA, and PhD degree programs on the basis of their 2nd last semester result of the respective qualifying degree. Such admissions shall be granted on a provisional basis, subject to the submission and verification of the final semester result and fulfillment of all admission requirements after the declaration of the result.

2. ADMISSION PROCESS

- 2.1. The applicants shall create an account on the UOG admission portal **OR** on UOG Mobile Application.
- 2.2. The applicants shall deposit Rs. 200/- per degree program for admission application processing charges.
- 2.3. Only Online complete application(s) along with compulsory documents shall be processed:
- Candidate's passport size photograph (with blue background and upto 300 x 350 pixels; JPG file).
 - Matriculation or equivalent Certificate / DMC issued by respective Board.
 - Intermediate (FIRST YEAR ONLY) / DAE (FIRST TWO YEARS) issued by respective Board.
 - Whereas; for 02 years degree programs the last terminal certificate / degree / Diploma shall be uploaded.
 - For Graduate Degree Programs terminal degree and transcript duly attested by Higher Education Commission (HEC), Islamabad.
 - NOC to apply for Graduate or Doctorate Degree Program (For in service applicants only).
- 2.4. In case of any discrepancy, fake documentation or concealment of facts, failure to produce terminal degree **OR** less than the required consolidated percentage of marks, the application shall not be processed **OR** admission shall be cancelled at any stage of the degree.
- 2.5. Considering eligibility, a candidate may apply for more than one degree programs.
- 2.6. The Admission Calendar for Fall-2026 is given in Annexure-III.

- 2.7. The change of subject within stipulated time shall only be allowed to the applicants who have already applied for the desired degree program(s) with the approval of respective Deans/Focal Persons/HODs subject to the availability of seats and eligibility.
- 2.8. Semester dues shall be refunded (if requested) within stipulated time as per UOG policy / rules.
- 2.9. Limited transport facility from the designated points shall be provided to the evening degree programs students.

3. DISPLAY OF MERIT LISTS AND FEE SUBMISSION

- 3.1. The **MERIT LISTS** of the selected candidates shall be displayed on the respective departmental notice board and UOG admission portal (<https://uog.edu.pk>) as per admission calendar (Annexure-III).
- 3.2. An applicant can file the admission grievance(s) (if any) along with all required documents in the office of the respective Faculty Dean for redressal within two working days after the notification/display of the merit list(s).
- 3.3. All the selected candidates mentioned in any merit lists shall appear before the respective Departmental Admission Committee along with all credentials (in original), CNIC / B-Form, two

passport size fresh photographs with blue background and two sets of attested copies of all credentials (Matric, Intermediate or equivalent, Diploma, other certificates etc.) placed in an ordinary paper folder within stipulated time before the notification/display of the next merit list to get Bank Challan for the semester fee/dues and securing of admission.

- 3.4. The admission dues/fee shall be deposited during the stipulated period in any branch of the Bank of Punjab or through banking mobile application using one link.
- 3.5. In case the semester fee/dues are not deposited within stipulated time, the admission offer shall stand cancelled.
- 3.6. Subject to the availability, hostel facility shall be provided to the candidates having domicile other than District Gujrat.
- 3.7. Equivalence Certificate of "A" Levels or Intermediate Certificate [awarded by the foreign institutions issued by the Inter Board Committee of Chairman (IBCC)] is mandatory at the time of registration.
- 3.8. Considering minimum required number of students per section and the departmental resources, the University reserves the right for not offering any degree program(s).
- 3.9. Considering above Para, if a degree program is not offered, the deposited semester dues shall be refunded as per UOG policy/rules.

4. AGE LIMIT FOR ADMISSION

- 4.1. The applicant's upper age limit shall be 25 years for Undergraduate Degree Programs (except for LLB) and 27 years for BS-Lateral Entry (5th Semester Induction) Degree Programs at the time of admission's closing date.
- 4.2. There is no upper age limit for LLB and Graduate Degree Programs.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA TO APPLY FOR MS/MPHIL OR EQUIVALENT DEGREE PROGRAMS:

- The applicants shall possess at least sixteen (16) Years of education (MA/MSc/BS or equivalent Degree Program in the relevant subject).
- The applicants shall have at least 45% marks in the Annual Examination System or 2.50 CGPA (out of 4.00 in the semester system) or 65% marks in the Semester System Examination, where CGPA is not mentioned at terminal degree required for admission in MS/MPhil or equivalent Program.
- The applicants shall have to earn at least, a cumulative 50% mark in the Departmental Subject Base Written Test (DSBWT) conducted by respective departments, UOG.

NOTE: a) MBA students with no Business Education background are required to complete 66 credit hours of coursework including the project. However, MBA students with relevant business education are exempted a maximum of 18 credit hours and they are required to complete a minimum of 48 credit hours of coursework including the project.

b) the applicants for MS in Governance & Public Policy shall possess at least sixteen years of education (MA/MSc/BS or equivalent degree programs in the relevant subject – Any Discipline from Social and Administrative Sciences)

INTRADISCIPLINARY QUALIFICATIONS:

- The intra disciplinary admission may only be allowed, if:
- The applicant has a strong interest in pursuing an MS/MPhil/MSc/LLM/equivalent degree in a different discipline.
- The applicant has passed the admission test with a minimum of 50% marks in the discipline of admission and has taken 6-9 CH of deficiency courses of level 6.
- Provided the GSC is satisfied that the applicant's knowledge of the primary area (level 6) has sufficiently prepared him or her to undertake the course of studies of the MS/MPhil/equivalent program.

MERIT DETERMINATION CRITERIA FOR MS/MPHIL OR EQUIVALENT PROGRAM:

Merit shall be calculated on the basis of marks obtained out of 100 according to the following criteria. However, securing a minimum of 50% marks in the UOG Admission Test shall be mandatory to qualify.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA TO APPLY FOR PHD DEGREE PROGRAMS:

- For admission in PhD programs, a minimum CGPA of 3.0 (out of 4.0 in the semester system) or 60% (in the annual system) in the MS/MPhil/MSc/LLM or equivalent degree being considered for admission, is required, whether such degree was obtained from Pakistani or foreign universities.
- If the CGPA/Percentage is not mentioned on the transcript, the candidate must produce equivalent weightage from the parent university.
- The students having strong demonstrated interest in obtaining PhD degree, but their CGPA is below 3.00 but above 2.5 (out of 4.0 in the semester system) or 60% marks (in the annual system) in the most recent degree obtained, may be admitted to a PhD program after fulfilling the following requirements:
 - Shall study additional courses of 9-12 CH of level 7 taking a zero semester at admission awarding university/HEI/DAI and score minimum 3.00 out of 4.00 GPA.
 - OR
 - Shall possess a minimum of three years of relevant industry or professional experience (directly related to their field of study and the degree program in which admission is sought), and
- Provided the GSC is satisfied that the applicant's knowledge of primary area (level 7) has sufficiently prepared him or her to undertake the course of studies of the doctoral program.
- These requirements shall be in addition to any other requirements set in this policy for admission to a PhD program.

INTRADISCIPLINARY QUALIFICATIONS:

The intra disciplinary admission may only be allowed, if:

- The applicant has a strong interest in pursuing a PhD in a different discipline.
- The applicant has passed DSBWT with minimum 50% marks in the discipline of admission and has taken 6-9 CH of deficiency courses of level 7.
- The GSC is satisfied that the applicant's knowledge of the primary area (level 7) has sufficiently prepared him or her to undertake the course of study of the doctoral program.

MERIT DETERMINATION CRITERIA FOR PHD PROGRAM:

Merit shall be calculated on the basis of marks obtained out of 100 according to the following criteria. However, securing a minimum of 60% marks in the UOG Admission Test or GRE/HAT General/Equivalent Test shall be mandatory to qualify.

ANNEXURE-II**DETAIL OF RESERVED SEATS IN UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAMS AND ADMISSION CRITERIA**

- 1) In addition to the above mentioned general admission criteria the following criteria shall also be applicable upon all reserved seats applicants.
- 2) The merit of the offered reserved seats shall be determined within the category; however, the applicant has to fulfill the general minimum admission eligibility criteria to apply for.
- 3) In case any reserved seat is not filled, the same shall be treated towards open merit.
- 4) In case if more than required nominations are received for a particular degree program, UOG shall reserve the rights to prepare the merit list as per UOG policy.
- 5) Subject to the eligibility a candidate may apply for more than one reserve quota.

- 6) The relevant document as proof of the reserve quota eligibility shall be required.
- 7) The reserved seats are only for the Morning Degree Programs offered at UOG and its Sub-Campus Mandi Bahauddin. However, no reserve seats are allocated in Two Years Associate Degree, Fifth Semester Induction, Graduate Degree Programs.

1) SPECIAL PERSONS:

- a. Two percent (2%) seats; at least one seat is reserved for special persons in all Undergraduate degree program except BSc Engineering degrees, Fifth Semester Induction and two years Associate Degree Programs.
- b. The applicant shall have to produce a certificate, duly issued by the District Disable Assessment Committee, by relevant District or Federal Government.
- c. The candidate shall have to appear before the UOG Medical Board / Committee for Medical Examination as per advertised schedule along with original credentials.
- d. Hard of Hearing shall not be considered as a disability.

2) SPORTS

- a. Two percent (2%) seats; at least one seat is reserved for sports persons in all Undergraduate degree programs except BSc Engineering degrees, Fifth Semester Induction and two years Associate Degree Programs.
- b. The applicant shall provide a registration certificate from Country / Provincial / District Sports Board along with certificate(s) of participation at inter college / board / province level issued by the concerned education department / board / province.
- c. Final selection shall be made on the basis of trials for each category/event/kind of sports that shall be held as per advertised schedule and venue at UOG.
- d. The University reserves the right to specify the category / event/ kind of sports as per its policy.

3) CHILDREN OF UOG EMPLOYEES

- a. Two (2%) seats; at least one seat is reserved for the children of UOG Regular BPS/TTS or Long-Term Contractual employees (excluding staff on deputation) in all Undergraduate programs.
- b. NADRA B-Form, UOG employment certificate issued by Registrar office shall be required along with admission application form.

1) EX FATA

- a. Two (2%) seat; at least one seat is reserved for the applicants belonging to EX FATA in all Undergraduate degree programs EXCEPT BSc Engineering degrees, Fifth Semester Induction and two years Associate Degree Programs.
- b. Considering KPK Govt. notification received dated March 10, 2020. The nomination letter is not required from the applicant however; domicile and CNIC of FATA shall be required.

5) BALOCHISTAN

- a. One (1%) seat; at least one seat is reserved for the applicants of Balochistan in all Undergraduate degree programs except BSc Engineering degrees, Fifth Semester Induction and two years Associate Degree Programs.
- b. The applicant shall produce nomination letter from the respective government.

6) GILGIT-BALTISTAN

- a. One (1%) at least one seat is reserved for the nominees of Gilgit-Baltistan region in all Undergraduate degree programs except BSc Engineering degrees, Fifth Semester Induction and two years Associate Degree Programs.
- b. The applicant shall produce nomination letter from the respective government.

7) AZAD JAMMU AND KASHMIR (AJK)

- a. One (1%) at least one seat for the nominees of Azad Jammu and Kashmir (AJK) region in all Undergraduate degree programs (other than fifth semester induction and two years Associate Degree Programs) offered by the Faculty of Arts and Faculty of Social Sciences, except BSc Engineering.
- b. The applicant shall produce nomination letter from the respective government.

8) AFGHANISTAN

- a. One seat for the nominees of Afghanistan in all undergraduate degree programs (other than fifth semester induction and two years Associate Degree Programs) offered by the Faculty of Social Sciences and Department of Mass Communication & Media only.

b. The applicant shall produce nomination letter from the respective Embassy in Pakistan.

9) WARDS OF SHUHADA, WAR DISABLED SERVING AND RETIRED INDIVIDUALS OF PAKISTAN ARMED FORCES

a. One percent (1%) seat(s); at least one seat is reserved for the Wards of Shuhada, war disabled, serving and retired individuals of Pak Army personnel in all Undergraduate degree programs except BSc Engineering degrees, Fifth Semester Induction and two years Associate Degree Programs.

b. The certificate of Wards of Shuhada, War disability or retirement issued by the army authority preferably GHQ shall be required.

10) MINORITIES

a. Two (2%) at least one seat for Minorities in all Undergraduate degree programs except BSc Engineering degrees and Fifth Semester Induction.

b. Computerized Birth Certificate issued by NADRA for the proof of claim as minority shall be required.

11) CHILDREN OF OVERSEAS PAKISTANIS

a. Five percent (5%) seats are reserved for the children of overseas Pakistanis in all degree programs EXCEPT BSc Engineering degrees and Fifth Semester Induction.

b. Terminal Certificate / Degree shall be from abroad.

c. Certificate / Degree Equivalence from IBCC or HEC respectively shall be required.

12) DISTRICT JINNAH PUBLIC SCHOOL AND COLLEGE, MANDI BAHAUDDIN

a. Ten percent (10%) of total seats in all Undergraduate degree programs offered at UOG Sub Campus Mandi Bahaiddin in morning are reserved for the students of DJPSC Mandi Bahaiddin on the basis of merit other than Fifth Semester Induction and two years associate degree programs).

13) CHILDREN OF ADVOCATES (RESERVED SEATS FOR LLB)

a. Five percent (5%) seats are reserved for the children of Advocates, in LLB (Hons) only.

b. Applicant shall produce parents' valid License issued by respective Bar Council.

c. Computerized Family Registration Certificate (FRC) / B Form issued by NADRA.
